

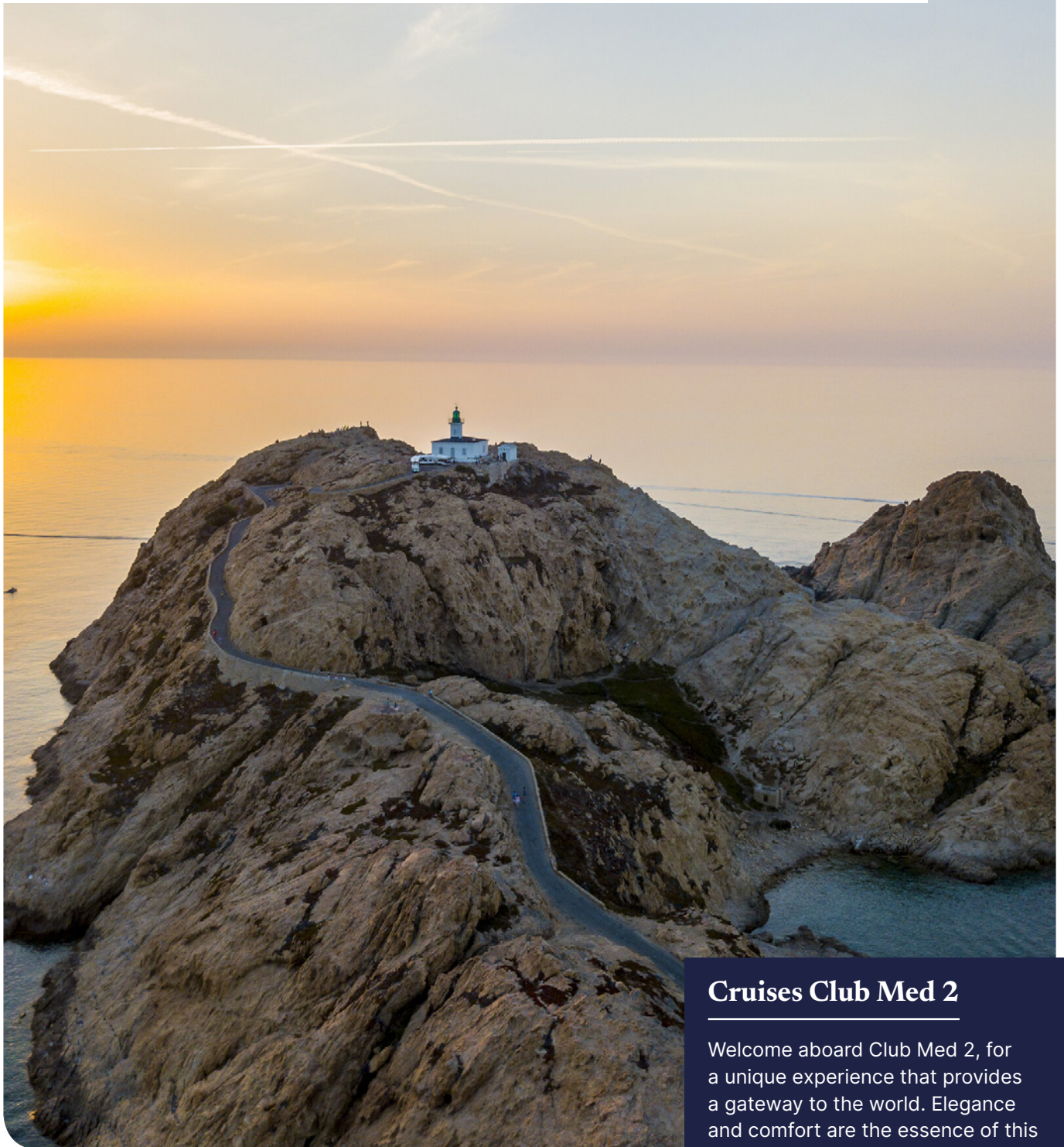

Day 1 - Monday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.
Day 2 - Tuesday PORTOFINO	This stunning fishing village nestling in the bay in the shade of the pine trees is sheer perfection in pastel hues, and a haunt for the jet set. Ship at anchor. Water sports.
Day 3 - Wednesday ILE ROUSSE	Founded by Paoli to rival the city of Calvi, this town is surrounded by fabulous islands of red porphyre and never-ending stretches of exotic beach. Ship at anchor, water sports available, beach.
Day 4 - Thursday NICE	From markets to the uber famous Promenade, it cultivates a love of flowers and the arts. It is full of vitality with ambiances that range from neoclassical elegance to the up-beat tempo of the old quarter. Boat docked, no water sports. Boarding and disembarkation port of call.

Excursions of your cruise

Day 2 - Tuesday PORTOFINO / CRUISE TO CAMOGLI*

Enjoy a guided boat ride to the San Fruttuoso's bay - famous for 11th century abbey hidden in a small creek. Discover the picturesque fishing village of Camogli and all the high perched houses, painted in pastel colors. Visit the amazing church of Santa Maria Assunta (closed on Mondays) and during your free time, walk through its narrow streets and along its small port. A village full of charms.

Day 3 - Wednesday ILE ROUSSE - LA BALAGNE VILLAGES*

Some of Corsica's most beautiful villages blend beautifully into the landscape of La Balagne. You'll take the scenic route, with superb views of the plain, the sea, the Bay of Calvi and the Ile Rousse. You'll discover the maquis, with its fabulous fragrance and vegetation, and the mediaeval village of Sant'Antonino, the island's most ancient village, perched up high on the rocks, where you'll have time to explore and enjoy a cool glass of Muscat.

Day 3 - Wednesday ILE ROUSSE / ALONG THE MOUNTAIN RIDGE IN A 4X4 U GUISSANI*

Spend half a day travelling through one of the most beautiful landscapes in Corsica, admiring the gorgeous Cap Corse and Pointe de la Revellata, not forgetting the breathtaking view from Padru, the highest summit in Balagne. Our adventure continues through the centuries-old olive groves of the Reginu valley.

Day 4 - Thursday NICE / MEDIEVAL EZE AND ITS EXOTIC GARDEN*

After admiring the wonderful landscapes of the Riviera through the middle cornice, you will visit one of the most picturesque perched villages in the region. You will walk through the alleys of the small medieval village of Eze to discover all the hidden charm. You will then visit the exotic garden that fills the ruins of the medieval castle and contemplate the most beautiful view of the Côte d'Azur and the Bay of Beaulieu in particular.

Formalities

CUSTOMS FORMALITIES

For all UK citizens, a valid passport is essential when you travel abroad. A full 10-year passport is required for holidays to all countries featured on our website. The passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date with one blank visa page. Make sure your passport is valid and check with the embassy or the consulate of your destination country if you need a visa for your chosen destination prior to travel. It is vital that the name given when booking your holiday (printed on the ticket and itinerary) is exactly the same as written on your passport. Any child, however old, must have his/her own passport. Please note Club Med cannot be held responsible for any issue with regards to passport or visas.

HEALTH FORMALITIES

Safe Together.

Club Med has implemented new hygiene and safety measures to offer you peace of mind and a most joyful experience.

As part of the fight against Covid-19, health measures at the borders are being reinforced and may in particular require a virological screening test (for example PCR test) depending on your country of origin, transit or destination before your departure and/or before your return.

We suggest you obtain more information from the consular services of the countries concerned or on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of your nationality and/or place of residence.

Recommended vaccinations: diphtheria, polio, tetanus, hepatitis A and B and typhoid.

Pregnant women who do not need constant medical supervision may come aboard, upon presentation of a medical certificate showing their due date and certifying that their pregnancy is compatible with the cruise.

The final day of the cruise must be before the end of the 26th week of pregnancy.

A doctor and a nurse are present on board.

Meeting place for boarding

Port of Nice. Commercial wharf (or sometimes Quai Admiral Infernet). The 2 docks are close, the port is small. We can not miss to see the CM2. Airport / port distance: 9 km (about 30 minutes). Paid open parking (located Quai Amiral Infernet). Website: www.riviera-ports.com.
